Experimental (Aptos, 12 point, bold, aligned left, first letter capitalized)

The experimental part should describe all the materials, methods, and equipment used.

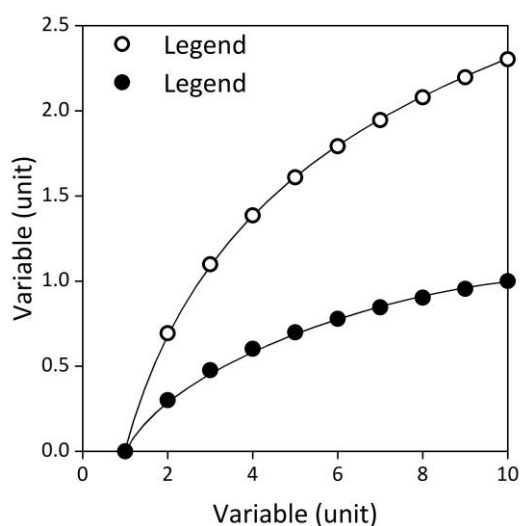


Figure Title. (Aptos, 12 point, italic, centered. One figure allowed.)

Results and conclusions (Aptos, 12 point, bold, aligned left, first letter capitalized)

The abstract should not exceed one A4 page with 2.5 cm top, bottom, right and left margins. The title should span in two rows maximum, followed by one blank line. Authors' first names should be followed by their family names, all written in full. Authors are expected to conclude the most important achievements and results at the end.

Acknowledgement (Aptos, 12 point, bold, italic, aligned left, first letter capitalized)

Inclusion of an acknowledgement is not obligatory. (Aptos, 12 point, justified, italicized.)
